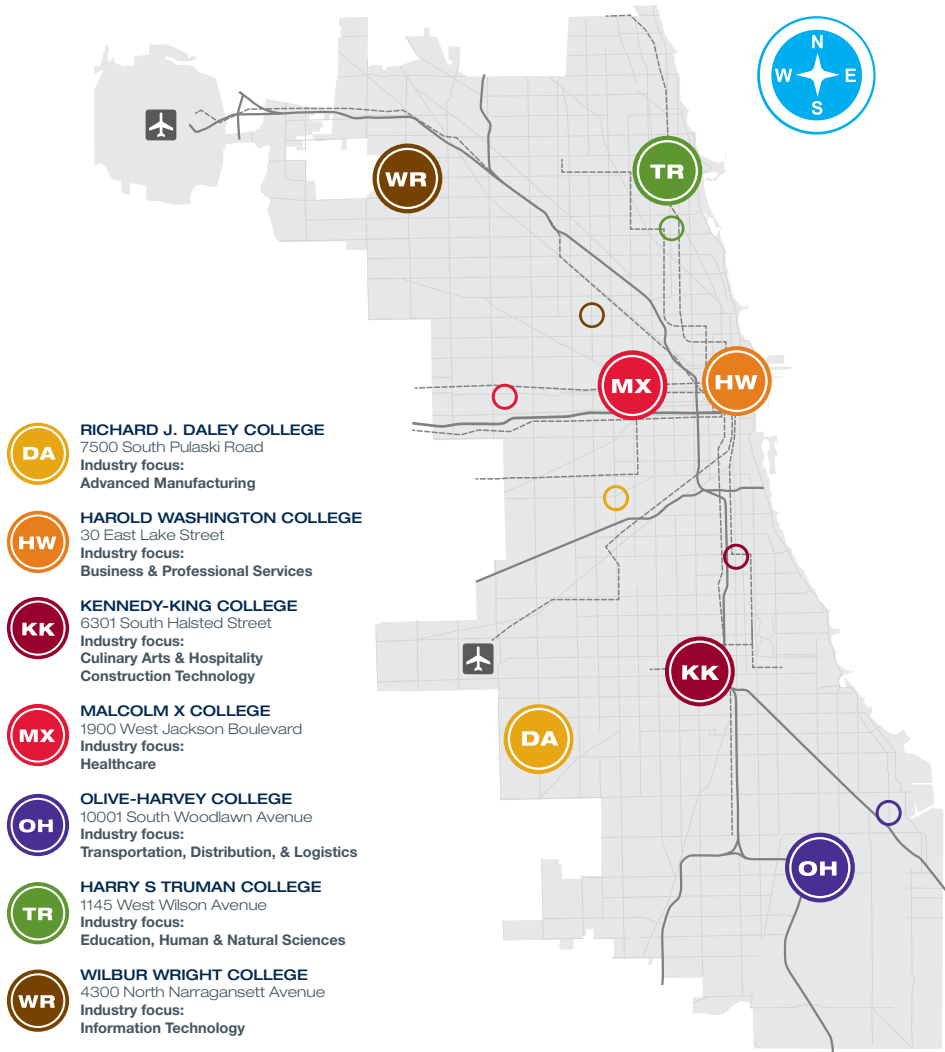

Health Science Summer Program

The Health Science Summer Program's mission is to prepare Chicago African-American high school students for a career in health science. The Health Science Summer Program is an intensive academic program intended for rising sophomores through seniors interested in pursuing a career in science.

Pre-Medicine

Rising Seniors

The Pre-College Health Science Scholars (PCHSS) summer program is a stimulating academic opportunity for motivated and focused rising high school sophomores, juniors and seniors who are interested in science careers. The purpose of the PCHSS Initiative is to strengthen the competitiveness of Chicago's pool of African-American high school students interested in science majors. The five week summer program also will provide valuable exposure to and insight into the field of health sciences. It is our goal to increase the number of African-American students who pursue health-related professions, enroll at Malcolm X College, and transfer to four-year institutions and professional schools.

Students will develop the skills necessary to be successful in a science career and emerge with greater knowledge and understanding of the field. The program will also allow students to get a head start on college at the world-class Malcolm X College!

- Essay: 150 Word Statement of Interest
- One Letter of Recommendation from Math/Science Teacher
- Completed Application
