Take these steps to ensure a smooth transfer or transition:

Schedule an appointment with your college's Transfer Director to learn about the transfer process and application deadlines.

2 **Research colleges and universities** with your desired major. Schedule college tours so you get to know the campus.

3 Schedule an appointment with your College Advisor to select the courses you need to help you transition to your top transfer destinations.

Get to know the college reps at each of your transfer destinations through their scheduled visits at your college.

5 Apply to your top five colleges/universities when you have 1-2 semesters remaining at CCC.

6 Research and apply for scholarships.

If you are considering an online program for your bachelor's degree, **take an online course** while at CCC to make sure it's the right fit.
