### Enrollment Requirements

- All students must verify residency in the State of Illinois by using one of the following: Valid State of Illinois Driver's License or State ID, Matricula Consular, or utility bills.
- Students age 16 or 17 must submit a release letter from the last school attended prior to testing.
- Enrollment is based on placement test scores and class availability.

## Program Options

### Gateway Scholar

Eligible Adult Education students begin taking college credit classes paid through a scholarship while working on their high school equivalency.

### Hybrid ESL

Busy life? Now you can learn English 50% online from anywhere and 50% in a classroom setting.

### High School Equivalency/ Spanish GED®

Take classes to prepare for the GED® or HiSET®.

### Online classes

Earn a high school equivalency certification from home or anywhere with an internet connection. Classes are completely online.
