Gateway to City Colleges of Chicago

In the Gateway to City Colleges of Chicago Program, Career Bridge completers and other eligible Adult Education students receive reduced tuition and supportive services for four semesters as they transition into credit certificate and degree programs.

Important Information

ESL Program Eligibility

- Must live in Illinois
- Social Security number is NOT required
- J1 visas are not permitted
- We accept 16-and 17-year old students, but they must submit a high school release form from their former high school. Please speak to staff from the Adult Ed program if you have never attended school in the United States.



Distance Learning

Adult Education classes are offered in a distance-learning format. Students connect with their teachers through Brightspace, Zoom, email, and phone calls.


